

**Privacy Policy
Your Privacy Rights (California)**

Intent

Best Transportation Systems, Inc. is committed to protecting the privacy of our customers and prospective customers in using the Best Transportation Systems, Inc. (“Best”) Web site and those Web sites of its affiliates and service providers (collectively the “Sites”). The Sites have been created to provide you useful information and to allow you to request additional information. As used herein, the terms “us,” “we,” or “our” means Best, or the affiliate of Best that provides you services and any agent, independent contractor, designee, or assignee that we may, at our sole discretion, involve in the provision of the Sites; “you” or “your” means (1) an individual or entity that is a user of the Sites or a party-in-interest, of the Sites, to an online user account, (2) an individual authorized by a user or a party-in-interest to view information and/or effect transactions, or (3) an individual or entity submitting an order via the Sites.

Information Collection and Use

In order to provide you with useful, timely information, the products and services you elect to purchase via the Sites, and to determine the effectiveness of the Sites, certain information about your connection will be collected. This information will assist us with improving the services we offer. Information that is collected includes the number of visitors we have, the time of the visit, the type of browser and operating system being used to access this site, and information regarding where the connection originated.

Personal or confidential information will be collected only with your consent. This information may include your name, phone number, e-mail address, or other information that identifies you personally or that you choose to provide if paying for any services you purchase through the Sites.

We will take every precaution to protect your personal and confidential information. When you enter personal information, it will be used only for the intended purpose. We will not sell, share, or redistribute this information to anyone outside of our affiliated or unrelated service providers retained to perform or assist in performing the services you purchase through the Sites.

Cookie/Tracking Technology

The Sites may use cookie and tracking technology depending on the features offered. Cookie and tracking technology are useful for gathering information such as browser type and operating system, tracking the number of visitors to the Sites, and understanding how visitors use the Site. Cookies can also help customize the Site for visitors. Personal information cannot be collected via cookies and other tracking technology; however, if you previously provided personally identifiable information, cookies may be tied to such information.

Distribution of Information

We may share information with governmental agencies or other companies assisting us in fraud prevention or investigation. We may do so when: (1) permitted or required by law; or, (2) trying to protect against or prevent actual or potential fraud or unauthorized transactions; or, (3) investigating fraud which has already taken place. The information is not provided to these companies for marketing purposes.

Security Measures

The security and confidentiality of information that we may obtain from you is extremely important, and we have implemented technical, administrative, and physical security measures to protect guest information from unauthorized access and improper use. From time to time we review our security procedures in order to consider appropriate new technology and new protection methods. Please be aware though that, despite our best efforts, no security methods are perfect or impenetrable.
